“The goal of early childhood education should be to activate the child’s own natural desire to learn” – Maria Montessori


Kindergarten is where the children come in and learn to become independent little beings. This is the place where they get their first wings and the confidence to spread their wings and start flying.




# Review Week






# Learning Pathway to Progress
